Action taken Report for the academic year 2017-18:

The college has successfully organized Parents-Teachers Meeting and received structured feedback from students which have been diligently analyzed for steering the institution towards an all inclusive development. Govt. have come out with G.O. for CAS promotion of teachers for alteration in the promotion process in tune with UGC regulation on 07 th December, 2017, as result of that G.O. some confusion was there regarding implementation of CAS promotion of 3 teachers whose files were cleared by IQAC and OIC of the College are kept on hold, until further clarification from higher authorities were received and all the 3 CAS related meeting was held in the first half of 2018 and all were promoted for which they applied.

NSS of the college have regularly undertaken activities like College Campus cleaning and Dustbin Installation Program, Diabetes Awareness program and Thalassaemia Awareness and screening test Program. A seminar on cybercrime was organized with the help of Nadia Dist Ploice Authority on the topic in presence of 3 IPS officers and other dignitaries.
